The data analysis reports are aggregate reports that provide a graph and chart of summarized data, based on the type of report. This can be filtered by date and client categories. This data is used to track trends or identify issues within a particular client group. The data gathered from data analysis can provide information on drug use, legal issues, suicidal thoughts, and services provided.






Fig. 2 Add Filters



The following is a description of the standard reports accessible through the Data Analysis Reports function

Report	Description
1. Age at Admission by Gender	View of age ranges by gender for tracking admission rates
2. Average # of Arrests and Charges	Provides insight on the level of criminal involvement of clients at the time of admission. Utilize this data to track reduced criminal involvements at discharge
3. Average # of Days of Substance Use in Past 30 Days	Review level of use rates of substances to determine level of substance use and morbidity rates
4. Average # of Legal Charges by Gender	Review the number of legal charges and the client's involvement within the criminal justice system
5. Average # of Years of Regular Substance Use	Review the chronic nature of clients' substance use. Utilize for morbidity rates and level of withdrawal
6. Diagnosis Count	This will provide a count of all diagnosis codes assigned to clients
7. Employment Status	Determine the percentage and count of clients' employment status at admission.
8. Gender	Compare the count and percentages of admissions for females and males
9. GPRA Measures	Use this report to measure alcohol use, abuse, and suicidal ideations at admissions
10. Living Arrangement	Review the status of living arrangements of clients' at admission



11. Percentage of Clients with Chronic Medical Conditions	Determine the rate of chronic medical problems clients' report at admission
12. Percentage of Methamphetamine Admissions	Determine the primary, secondary or tertiary rate specifically for Methamphetamine admissions.
13. Referral Sources	Track referral sources for all clients at time of admission
14. Service Provided	Track all services offered for your agency throughout the treatment process.
15. Substance of Major Problem	Determine the trends of the substance of major problem identified by clients at admission
16. Suicidal Thoughts	Determine the suicide thoughts rate for clients for the 30 days prior to admission and lifetime
