## AI Reporting: Printing an ASI Assessment Biopsychosocial Narrative

To print a report in OakTree you will need to run a selected form or forms against the AI Tool. This compiles your form inputs into a report. The report is then printed in the Report Viewer. The following steps will show you how to create the report.

- 1. First select the client
- 2. Open the Client Summary
- 3. Check the box next to the patient assessment
- 4. Click the [AI Tool] button (this will compile your inputs to create your report)
